### **Public Participation**

- (i) A member of the public raised concern regarding the potential planning application that backs on to Thornton Road. The Council informed the member of the public this application cannot be discussed until the application is received.
- (ii) Mr. Lawtey read out a statement asking if the Parish Council have been involved in any discussion with NLC and Keigar regarding possible planning applications and finding allocations. The Council informed the meeting no meetings or discussions have taken place.
- (iii) Ward Cllr Peter Clark confirmed 3 separate payments will be going to 3 separate places under S106 Of the Hawthorn Gardens planning application.
- (iv) Clarification given to the meeting that the strip of land located off Chapel Street is not part of the Hawthorn Gardens planning application.
- (v) Hawthorn Gardens site visit will take place 13<sup>th</sup> March and members of the public can attend but cannot take part.
- (vi) Mr. Ruddy requested an additional grit bin to be located near to the Parish Rooms Notice board, North End. Will be added to Aprils agenda for cost approval.
- (vii) Mr. Roberts raised concern that the site visit to Hawthorn gardens application would not present an accurate reading of the potential risk, more specifically previous flooding.
- (viii) Ward Cllrs informed the meeting any pictures or evidence supporting the objection to the Hawthorn Gardens planning application to be sent to the case officer.

- (x) Path 64 (Trinity Close off Horsegate Field Road) has been raised as a potential Hazard as the public footpath is lower than the local ground.
